Every paid member will have a single vote. They can vote (via secret ballot) on the day of the AGM by depositing their voting slip in the ballot box which will be kept with the Returning Officer. The details of the voting slip will be sent out separately once the nominations for the various posts are received. The votes will be tallied by the returning officer who will announce the results at the AGM. Please be present on the day.

The AIMA AGM will commence at **10:00 am** on the **18th August 2024**. The current committee will present the reports for the previous term and will be available to take questions from the members. Once the returning officer announces the results the new committee will be installed and approved by the membership.
